## Materials Express manuscript checklist

There is no abbreviation in <i>Title</i> .  First names of all authors are given in full (not initialized).  PIN code and country are mentioned for all affiliations.  Corresponding author is marked* and corresponding e-mail address is given.  At least 5 keywords are given.  Manuscript is page-numbered.
Section headings are given.  Article has sections and subsections, sequentially numbered.  Communication has only 4 main sections (no sub-section).  Communication has maximum 4 figures.  There is no supporting information appendix.
References are properly formatted. First name (initialized) followed by surname. All authors' names are given (NO et al.). Full article title is given in sentence case (only the first word capitalized, not all). Journal name is properly shortened (as per standard recommendations). Year is given at the end (bold and bracketed).
All components of a figure are given on the same page.  Figure components are labelled as (a), (b), (c) Not as (A), (B), (C) or a), b), c)  Figure captions are given under each figure (on the same page).  Any scheme, photo, flowchart etc. is termed as <b>Figure</b> and sequentially numbered.  There is no reference in figure caption (except for Review articles).  While presenting any pre-published figure, the figure caption must state like this:  Reproduced with permission from [Ref No.] A. Matsuda et al., Sol. Energy Mater Sol. Cells 78, 3 (2003). © 2003, Elsevier.
